

DIVE SITES DIRECTORY

Explore five of the best local dive sites with Knowledgeable, qualified guides. Just five minutes away, Neptune Reef is a haven for trigger, lion and crocodile fish, alongside octopus and honeycomb moral eel, with a maximum depth of five meters making it ideal for beginners.

ZENGUELEMA DIVE SITE

By comparison Zenguelema has a maximum depth of 18 meters and this dive site is only available at low tide due to currents.

Only a 15 minutes boat Journey away, it features a sloping wall that is home to large clams, reef fish and dazzling coral.

TWO MILE REEF DIVE SITE

The two mile is our most popular location, with plenty of dive sites to explore.

The coral reefs start at a depth of five meters and slowly descend to a maximum depth of 22 meters, making it possible to see large school of Reef fish, turtle, rays and Reef sharks, as well as occasional visits by dolphins, dugong, and even humpback whale.

NORTH POINT DIVE SITES

Brindle bass ridger (north point) with a maximum depth of 18 meters. This large reef features impressive concentrations of snappers, angelfish, rubber lips, brindle bass and Reef sharks.

MANTA RAY REEF (NORTH POINT)

Afloat Reef with spectacular concentrations of anemones sheltering both nose strip and two bar clownfish the reef is often frequented by green turtles and rays with a maximum depth of 15 meters

TURTLE RIDGE (NORTH POINT)

A narrow ridge with a depth of 14 meters: frequented by turtles and game fish such as barracuda.
