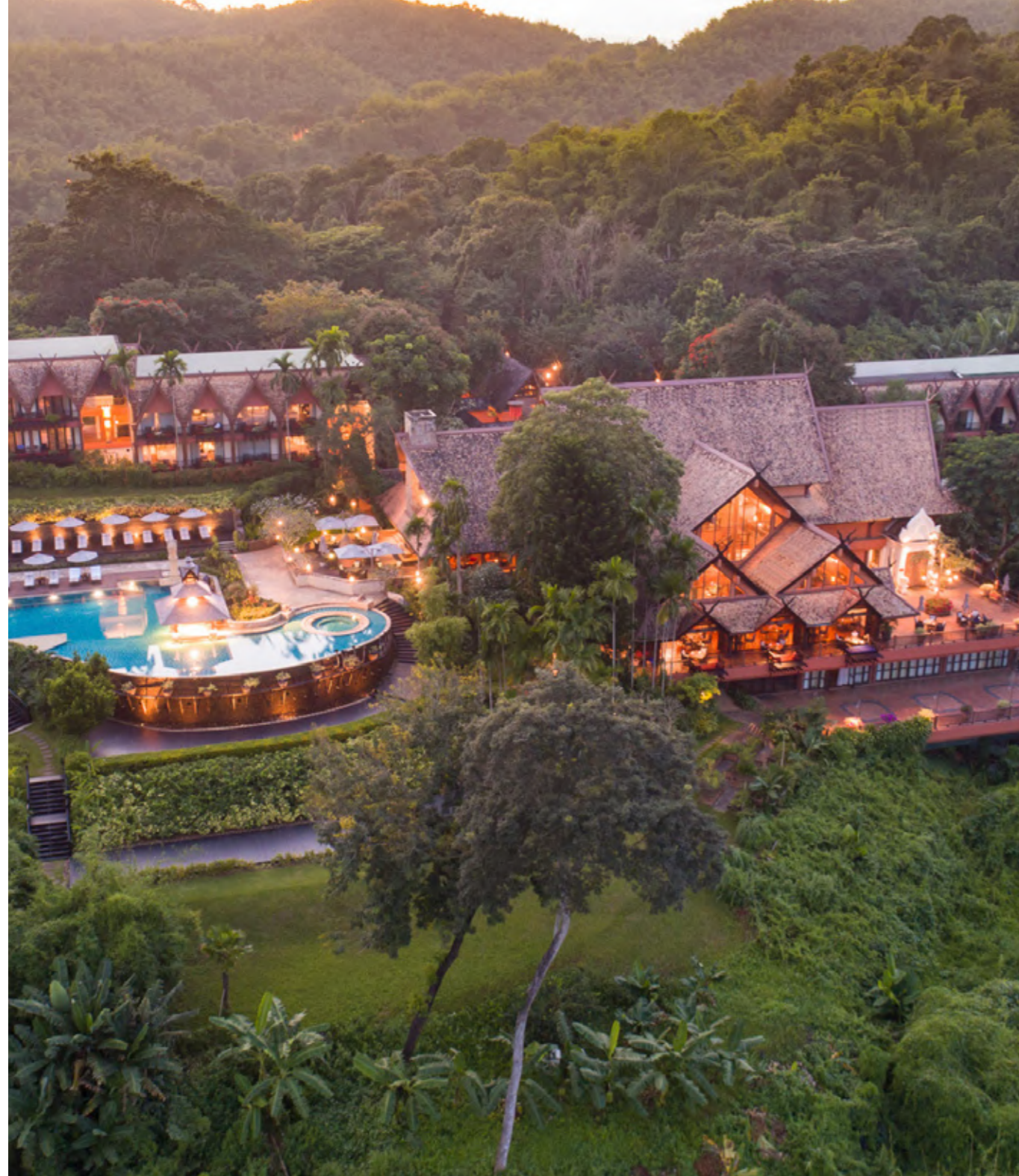
OUR STORY
