We love a fancy beach resort. But what gets us really revved up is a luxury beach home like the Layan Residences by Anantara.

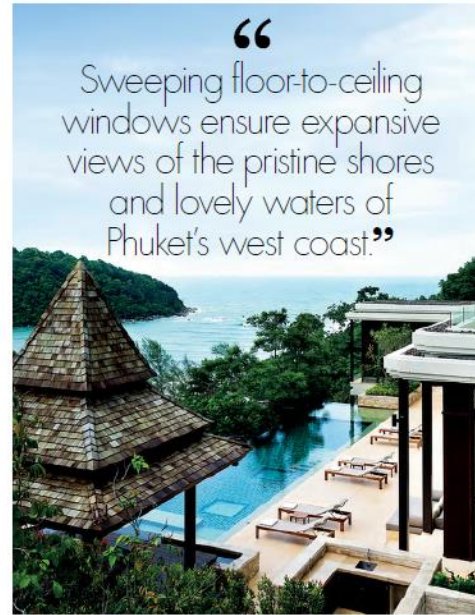
