
Each impeccable Jim Thompson design reflects the lush, tropical gardens as well as the sweeping sea views all around.


JIM THOMPSON

Biography

James H. W. Thompson's was born in Greenville, Delaware, in 1906. He worked as an architect in New York until the beginning of the Second World War. During the war, Thompson served in the army, and it was in this capacity that he came to Asia as part of a group scheduled to parachute into Thailand. The beauty and friendliness of the country and its people immediately appealed to him, and, upon receiving his discharge from the service, he decided to make Thailand his home.

In 1951, he created the world-famous silk company that has become synonymous with Thai sophistication and design.

The business was by no means an overnight success but Thompson's confidence and commitment attracted more weavers and steadily more customers. A major turning point was the decision to use Thai silk for costumes in "The King and I", both on the stage and in the film version. Fashion designers and interior decorators were also attracted to the shimmering fabric, and exports, as well as local sales, began to expand. By the 1960s, there were over a hundred other silk companies in Thailand, giving employment to thousands of Thais, and silk had become perhaps the country's most famous single product.



In March 1967, Jim Thompson went on holiday with friends to the Cameron Highlands, Malaysia. One Sunday during their trip, he went for a walk in the surrounding jungle and never returned, leaving behind an enduring mystery.
