

FISHING CHARTERS

Big Game Fishing & Deep-Sea Fishing Excursion

The Quirimbas National Park (QNP) is a protected area in the Cabo Delgado Province of Mozambique, encompassing the southern part of the Quirimbas Islands, as well as a significant mainland area. The park was established in June 2002. It stretches for 110 kilometres along the northeast coast of Mozambique. The archipelago is protected by strict conservation policies. A tag and release practice ensures sustainability and plentiful prize catches for all. These waters are renowned for sailfish, wahoo, blue striped and black marlin, kingfish, queenfish, barracuda, mackerel and yellowfin tuna among others. The season is pretty much year-round. Big game and heavy tackle fishing are at its best in the summer months between September to April. Sailfish peak season is usually in winter between May and September. Charters take place from our 9-metre gulf craft where captain and crew are on hand to help select the right tackle and give guidance.

OCEAN SAFARI

Set out on an offshore boat trip to view some of the Indian Ocean's most mesmerising sea creatures. Crystal clear ocean depths are perfect for observing the bottlenose dolphin and if possible, even socialising with them. Leatherback, loggerhead and green sea turtles are often spotted from the boat or while snorkelling, giving you a unique experience to be side by side with these gentle creatures. Look out for humpback whales from July to October during their annual great migration to breed and give birth. Snorkel at one of the most unique and untouched marine ecosystems in Mozambique where over 2 000 fish species inhabit the reef.
