

Pets policy





PETS ALLOWED

- Dogs and cats only
- Max. 25 kg

INCLUSIONS

- Pet mat / per bed
- Bowls for water and food

RATES

• 50 EUR per pet / per night

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Pets are not allowed to stay alone in the room.
- Pets are not allowed to be in the common food and beverage areas of the hotel (bars, restaurants, breakfast areas, terraces with food service, etc.).
- The rules indicating in which spaces pets are not allowed do not apply for guide dogs.
- The use of a dog leash is mandatory in common areas of the hotel.
- Any damage caused by the animal will be the responsibility of the owner and a charge will be made to the credit card for the replacement of the damaged object.
- In case of noise or inconvenience caused by the pet, the hotel reserves the right to cancel the reservation of the guest.
- The pets are not allowed to use the bath or showers of the rooms.
- It is not allowed to use the towels or sheets for cleaning the pets.
- Owners should provide the necessary food and hygiene products for their pet's stay, with the exception of the items mentioned above in the inclusions section.

MAIN LOCAL REGULATIONS ABOUT DOGS IN PUBLIC AREAS

- Keep your dog on a leash. In pedestrian zones and on streets
 with heavy pedestrian traffic as well as in public buildings or on
 public transport, dogs must be kept on a leash no longer than 1
 metre. Dangerous breeds are required to wear a muzzle. In public
 parks and woodland, the leash may be up to 2 metres long.
- Dog owners are obliged by law to pick up their dogs faeces and dispose of it in a public litter bin. Failure to do so may incur a penalty fee.
- While Tunisia is a pet friendly country, pets are not usually allowed in public transport unless they are very small and kept in a sealed container.
