Even more Classique than the Blanc the Blancs is the L'Ormarins Brut Classique, combining the base wine grape varietals Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Amongst which Chardonnay grapes are domineering. The palate is citrus focused at the beginning, transforming into a broad, creamy mouthful. The flavours of the lees harmonise nicely with the acidity. Delicate peach hue. Constant stream of fine bubbles. Appealing aroma of candied apple, citrus pith and light flinty, limestone nuance. Distinctly fruity white peach and apple entry.

Steenberg 1682 Brut Chardonay NV USD 60 Constantia.

Attractive delicate salmon pink hue in appearance. Delicious whiffs of charming raspberry and strawberry aromas vie with a peppery spice nuance on the nose. The palate is vivid with lively bubbles of bright red berries and crisp acidity. Providing equilibrium are rich, creamy lees notes and

toasted biscuit flavours from its secondary fermentation in bottle. Delightfully playful yet serious with good structure, length, and a clean, focused finish.

Colmant Brut Rosé

Franschhoek.

Notes of white floral and intricate notes of citrus peel, quince and grapefruit rise to the surface in a fine, vibrant mousse. Pinot Noir adds palate weight to balance the vibrant Chardonnay acidity, complete with a chalky minerality that adds to the length.

Graham Beck Blanc de Blancs

USD 90

Robertson.

Bright lime green colour with rich aromas of fresh limes, green apples, pears and lemon zest on the nose. Delicately balanced flavours of succulent citrus, brioche and spice combines with yeasty complexity, broadening the palate with layered textures and leading to a long finish.years. It is rose gold in colour, with a fine effervescence, offering the perfect balance between strength and delicacy.



Sauvignon Blanc

Almenkerk Lace Sauvignon Blanc USD 30 Elgin.

The Almenkerk Sauvignon shows upfront fruity aromas of elderflower, gooseberry, white peach and capsicum underbuilt by fresh granny smith apples, cut grass and flinty river pebbles. Built on natural acidity and a core of minerality. This wine has a rounded mouthfeel & lingering finish due to the extended lees contact.

Lomond Sauvignon Blanc USD 35

Cape Aghulas.

A bright and vibrant wine. On the nose, the wine is showing white fruit, hints of kiwi fruit, and minerality. The palate is welcomed by layers of fruit that gives the wine great complexity and dimension.

Paul Cluver Sauvignon Blanc USD 40

Elgin, South Africa.

This bright Sauvignon blanc with a touch of a green hue shows an impressive range of aromas on the nose. A combination of passion fruit, black current and grapefruit on the nose with hints of mineral notes.

The expression of the nose follows through to the palate, passion fruit, gooseberry, but with great salinity, complexity and length. The wine is fresh, with great balanced acidity and a lingering finish.

Cederberg Sauvignon Blanc USD 30

Cederberg. An aromatic Sauvignon Blanc with a combination of tropical, citrus and green aromas.

Aromas of gooseberries, guava, lemon zest with hints of asparagus and green fig. A refreshing, crisp acidity finishes off the initial sensation of creaminess on the mid-palate.

Klein Constantia 'Metis'

USD 70

Constantia. Historic Klein Constantia, where vines enjoy fresh breezes from the ocean on either side of the Cape peninsula, is known for its classic expression of this variety. Top- drawer Metis is made in collaboration with their French consultant.

Chardonnay

Paul Cluver Ferricrete Chardonnay USD 35 *Elgin.*

A great expression of a lightly oaked Chardonnay, bursting with citrus and fresh Granny Smith apple notes. Followed by nuances of white peach and complemented with subtle hints of oak.

These characteristics follow through onto the palate whet reveals natural, fresh and fine acidity, with a lingering finish.

Glenelly The Glass Collection USD 40 Unoaked Chardonay

Stellenbosch.

The nose is aromatic, with tropical fruits and light notes of white flowers. On the palate, it's light and well balanced, showing flavours of mango and pineapple.

Moderate acidity makes the wine approachable.

Cape of Good Hope Serruria y USD 60

Franschhoek. Shy orange blossom bouquet with a whiff of spice too. Fresh, lively and zippy in the mouth with ample orange and citrus flavour cloaked with creamy vanilla oak.

The flavours grow like a peacock fantail, starting off quite reserved and then revealing more depth and richness. Lovely harmonious integration of oak and fruit. Long and yet light and bright.



Chardonnay

Paul Cluver Estate Chardonnay

USD 65

Elgin.

Super elegant, well balanced, barrel fermented chardonnay, matured in small French oak for 9 months. Clean citrus and pear characteristics, true to the cool climate origin.

Radford Dale Vinum Chardonnay

USD 60

Stellenbosch.

Pale gold in colour with vibrant green tinge. Lemon blossom and mandarin notes combine on the nose, while a touch of brioche hints at barrel fermentation. Lively acidity and lemon zest add zip to the palate after which white peach lead into a generously round mid palate. The finish is taut and crisp leaving one with a clean, mineral lift.

Chenin Blanc

Painted Wolf 'The Den' Chenin Blanc USD 30

Swartland.

This is a vibrant, zesty Chenin Blanc packed with flavour. The painted wolf, also known as the African wild dog, is a highly social animal that bases most of its interaction around its den. Chenin is the most versatile food-pairing grape, so enjoy this wine with a wide variety of dishes.

Kumusha Chenin Blanc

USD 30

Breedekloof.

Aromas of pears, white peach and lime on the nose. A juicy palate with flavours of cantaloupe melon and papaya, following through with a crisp dry finish.

Revneke Organic Chenin Blanc

USD 35

Stellenbosch.

Notes of quince, pear and yellow apple are apparent on the nose, with notes of star fruit and sweet pineapple. The palate is fresh and vibrant, showing flavours of lemon zest and apple. The wine has well integrated acid, a very good structure, core and a nice long finish.

Lievland Chenin Blanc

USD 45

Pearl.

Aromas of citrus fruit, peach, pear and honey are inviting. This wine has moderate acidity supporting stonefruit, apple and a light note of linden tea on the palate. It finishes with notes of lemon.

Beaumont Hope Marguerite

USD 60

Bot River.

This old vines Chenin Blanc shows dried apricot, marzipan and spice on the nose and hints of green apple, apricot and well-integrated oak on the palate.

Raats Old Vine Family Reserve

USD 65

Stellenbosch.

Bruwer Raats takes this variety from the Loire Valley in France very seriously. He coaxes aromas of Golden Delicious apples and pineapples, and citrus flavours from the grape, complementing this with some finely judged oaking in French barrels. Pairs excellently with a wide variety of dishes.

De Trafford Chenin Blanc

USD 95

Stellenbosch.

Attractive pale yellow pale-yellow dusty apricot and ripe melon on the nose at first with lemon, honey and floral notes. Soft though elegantly textured and complex palate with a moderately rich mid palate and a long, creamy finish. Excellent with rich fish, seafood, and sushi. Already showing a lot of complexity - drink now to 2025.



Premium White Blends

Bouchard Finlayson Blanc De Mer USD 45

Hemel-en-Aarde.

A fountain of flowery aromas alerts first impression success. The taste is characterised by hints of quince, apricot and almonds with a comforting creamy middle and a bold seamless surround. Fresh and vibrant, with a convincing strength and quality finish.

Sutherland Viognier- Roussanne USS 40

This white wine blend's grapes grow all on one block, bringing different grape varietals with the same terroir conditions into one bottle. Richness through Roussanne and Viognier lifted by acidity and fruitiness through Chenin Blanc and Verdelho.

Pinot Grigio

Terra Del Capo Pinot Grigio USD 35

Franschhoek.

Tangy light peach and golden apple aromas with a waft of stone fruit and light floral hints. The palate is equally light with nectarine and peach flavour. A brush of honeysuckle richness vies with the vibrancy of freshly grated lime zest. Lovely balance of acidity and rounded honey richness which lingers long.

Rosé

Cederberg Sustainable Rosé USD 25

Cederberg.

This Shiraz-based Rosé has a pale salmon-pink hue and displays flavours of strawberry mousse, rose petals and just-ripe nectarines, followed by a mineral rich finish.

Jordan Chameleon Dry Rosé USD 30

Stellenbosch.

A dry classic French "blanc de noir" style made from a

free-run juice blend of shiraz and merlot. Extended prefermentation skin contact gives the wine its brilliant cherrypink hue. Harvested earlier to retain fresher acids and treated very reductively in the cellar, this helps to capture the primary fruit flavours of strawberry coulis & dried cranberries with delicate spiciness.

Waterford Rosé – Mary USD 35

Stellenbosch.

A wine consisting of delicate apricot, fresh cherry, white floral and citrus blossom on the aromatics, with hints of fresh oregano. The palate is invitingly fresh with nartjie, apricot and young nectarine flavours following through to a long aftertaste.

Pinot Noir

Iona Mr P Pinot Noir

USD 35

Elgin.

Elegant, fresh cherry and red berry nose, with undergrowth melange. The palate is pure with lovely texture and sweet cherry fruit dominates with spicy undertones. The wine is fresh and intense with real vibrancy.

Thelema Sutherland Pinot Noir USD 50 *Elgin.*

This Pinot Noir was aged in French oak barrels for 9 months and shows pure strawberry fruit aromas and lovely perfumed spice and earthy characters on the nose. The wine is wonderfully balanced with a long, refined finish.

Bouchard Finlayson 'Galpin Peak' USD 120

Hemel-en-Aarde.

Much in demand, this fine Pinot is grown in the cool Walker Bay valley. Made in a serious, savoury style, with pure cherry and cranberry flavours and underlying earthiness, it is an ideal accompaniment to duck and has sufficient structure to accompany lighter red meat dishes.



Sangiovese

Terra Del Capo Sangiovese

USD 35

Franschhoek.

Bright cherry- and blueberry aromatics which then give way to a palate packed with similar juicy, cherry flavour. Spicy highlights too. Smooth, rounded and delightfully ripe, the vivacious fruitiness is skilfully balanced by a gentle hint of oak which adds depth. Complex and yet approachable, it lingers with a light cocoa farewell.

Pinotage

Painted Wolf 'The Den' Pinotage

USD 25

Paarl.

An intense fruit packed wine with a smorgasbord of red and black summer berries, savoury spice and toasty wood flavours. The wine has firm savoury tannins which will smooth out over the coming months. It has a long finish.

Beaumont Jackals River Pinotage USD 45

Bot River.

A small, family run wine Estate in the cooler Overberg region of South Africa making some of the country's best Pinotage, a grape unique to Africa! Excellent ripeness and quality from low yield vineyards gives an intense, deep colour with ripe fruit, black cherries, plums and spice on the nose.

Kaapzicht Steytler Pinotage USD 120

Stellenbosch. Sweet spice, freshly picked red plums, black cherries and cola are supported by aromatic toasted coconut and milk chocolate from the youthful oak.

The bright cored palate of the wine shows more elegance and freshness, but retains the characteristic fine grained, polished tannin structure that is accessible and mouth-watering.

Merlot

Bein Little Merlot

USD 30

Stellenbosch.

Attractive fruity wine with typical Merlot bouquet, showing berries and soft refreshing spiciness finished with subtle tannins

Glenelly The Glass Collection

USD 32

Stellenbosch.

The Glass Collection Merlot is a deep rich coloured wine. It displays intense dark fruit aromas and spicy plums; the wine reminds one of a Black Forrest Gateaux. This Merlot shows tremendous concentration, richness and generous fruit on the palate with fine but well-balanced tannins to embrace it all.

De Trafford Merlot

USD 90

Stellenbosch.

Attractive deep red colour. Lovely spice, plums and other beguiling dark fruit on the nose. Hints of fynbos (herbal) notes and complimentary oak component. These flavours follow through on the big, but fine palate. Generous alcohol, complex fruit, firm fine tannins and acidity balance each other to give a plush mouthfeel and lingering aftertaste.



Syrah

Lomond Syrah

USD 30

Cape Aghulas.

Abundant aromatic flavours of white pepper with dark fruit and well- structured tannins. Elegant.

Kaapzicht Suidooster Shiraz

USD 40

Stellenbosch.

The weathered granite soils at Kaapzicht favour Shiraz, imparting naturally low yields of perfectly ripe fruit. Fermented in stainless steel, then aged in half-new French oak for two years, the result is a sufficiently light-footed, stylish red.

Stark-Conde Stellenbosch Syrah 750ml (Ltd Release)

USD 50

Stellenbosch.

This wine is a deep purple tinged colour. Concentrated dark fruit aromas with liquorice and violet and white pepper notes. The palate is rich and broad with layers of fruit and a fine-grained tannin structure.

Rust En Vrede Stellenbosch USD 220 Reserve Syrah

Stellenbosch.

Fruit is layered with sweet spicy notes of nutmeg, all spice and a touch of vanilla. The palate is plush with soft, ripe tannins and a juicy mid palate showing that same combination of red band black fruit.

Cabernet Savignon

Bosman Generation 8 Cabernet Sauvignon

USD 35

Wellington.

Beautiful blackberry and raspberry aromas are rounded out by a long, fresh, fruit-packed finish. A velvety mouth feel with a Fruity, lingering finish.

Thelema Mountain Vineyard USD 65 Cabernet Sauvignon

Elgin.

Thelma was at the forefront of the 'new dawn' of winemaking in the early 1990s, producing distinctively modern-styled and accessible Cabernets, with the ability to age well. The concentrated blackcurrant and blackberry flavours, with a hint of mint and eucalyptus, are in perfect balance with the tannins.

Springfield Methode Ancienne USD 95 Cabernet Sauvignon

Robertson.

Tiny berries, intense in colour and flavour proffer a meagre crop, which is vinified in the traditional 'ancient' way: no crushing of berries, no added yeasts and no fining and filtration, ensuring rich, concentrated blackcurrant flavours underpinned by fine, supple tannins.

Rustenberg 'Peter Barlow' USD 130 Cabernet Sauvignon

Stellenbosch.

A benchmark South African Cabernet from this venerable estate, which impresses with its classic flavours and refined tannins. Blackberry, black cherry and cedar on a full nose. Vanilla, dark chocolate and tobacco leaf on a full-bodied palate. Simply stunning. It oozes class with layers of complexity, which will continue to evolve for many years. A truly incredible wine.



Red Blends

Hartenberg Cabernet - Shiraz

Stellenbosch.

Well-regarded Shiraz producer, Hartenberg decided to produce a more accessible blend, without losing their signature classic, savoury style. Enjoy with roasted meats and pasta dishes.

Kaapzicht Bottelary Hills Red Blend

USD 35

Bottelary.

This stylish and powerful red blend is our all-rounder with notes of dark berries and cherries. The palate boasts richness, concentration, and dense fruit.

Reyneke Organic Shiraz / Cabernet Sauvignon

USD 45

Stellenbosch.

Johan Reyneke's aim has always been to express the uniqueness of the soils, dotted with Stone Age hand axes, in his wines. His Shiraz/ Cabernet is elegant and pure, with vibrant black cherry and peppery edge. Accessible and juicily fruited for easy enjoyment.

Iona One Man Band Red Blend

USD 50

Elgin.

Elegant with ripe, juicy red and black fruit. Lovely white pepper and sweet, exotic spice on the nose. The entry is intense, with underlying cedar wood, followed by a long savoury, earthy finish with fine grained tannins.

Boekenhoutskloof The Chocolate Block

USD 60

Franschhoek.

Sought-after, sleek blend of (mostly) shiraz and grenache with a beguiling rich, spiciness after the traditional reds of the Southern Rhône. Dense, and vibrantly youthful, enjoy the voluptuous mouth feel, and long, complex finish.

AA Badenhorst Family Red

USD 90

Swartland.

A sought-after, intriguing blend of Shiraz, Grenache, Cinsault, and Tina Barocca from rock-star Swartland winemaker, Adi Badenhorst. Beautifully perfumed, redfruited and complex, with a confident grip and fine texture.

Meerlust Rubicon

Stellenbosch.

One of the first Cape Bordeaux-styled blends from this internationally renowned estate. The Rubicon is consistently restrained and quietly understated in style, rewarding time in the bottle. Winemaker, Chris Williams attributes the quality of Meer lust's wines to passionate viticulture and cool breezes from the nearby Southern Ocean

Beaumont 'Starboard'

Port-Style Wine

Bot River.

A fine, quirky 'Port blended from five vintages by Sebastian Beaumont. Tinta Barocca and Pinotage grapes are partially fermented, then lightly fortified. The result is amazing - like a Ruby Port, but spicier and more complex.

Paul Cluver Noble Late Harvest

USD 60

Elgin.

A very expressive nose, with apricot and pineapple aromas dominating. Soft cardamom pod fragrances and orange blossom are noticeable too. All these characteristics follow through onto the luscious, creamy palate which finishes clean.
