Have you heard of this? Coravin is a technique (a device really) that lets you pour a glass of wine without removing the cork. That means that every bottle remains fresh and you can enjoy the full flavour of the wine from the first glass to the last. We have chosen some absolute beauties to include in our Coravin list, all of them iconic.

CORAVIN RED WINES

Château Musar, 2017 Cabernet Sauvignon/Cinsault/Carignan  €30
Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

Yes, from Lebanon, and from what is probably that country's best-known wine estate with a heritage of nearly 100 years. Extremely rich and full bodied, with a hint of middle east spices, Chateau Musar of Gaston Hochar comes from the amazing terroir of Bekaa Valley, which lies between two mountain ranges. The grapes are harvested by hand by local Bedouin people and the winemaker uses sustainable organic techniques to create a beautifully balanced composition of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cinsault and Carignan.

Giacomo Fennocchio Barolo, 2019 Nebbiolo  €32
Piedmonte, Italy

Is Barolo the 'wine of kings' or the 'king of wines'? Both, we'd say, and the best ones are intense, complex and seriously age-worthy. Bussia is one of the best crus of Barolo and is excellent expression of the elegance and balance for which this area is famous. Notes of wild berries, rose petal, floral and minty notes are all here.

Beaune 1er Cru, Róisín Curley, Burgundy, 2021 Pinot Noir   €40
Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France

The first of our Irish Geese bottles, this is a very special wine from a very special person. Originally from County Mayo, Róisín learnt in some of France's finest vineyards, including Château Latour and Château Grillet. In 2015 she realised her dream of making her own wine in her favourite wine region, Burgundy. There she started her micro-negociant business, Maison Róisín Curley.

CORAVIN RED WINES

Masi Costasera, 2018, Amarone della Valpolicella   €30

Veneto, Italy

In Italian the name Amarone literally literally means “Great Bitter” , another famous wine made by using sun-dried grapes, apart from beloved and popular at that time sweet Recioto, and both take their roots from Veneto.

This is a rich, stunning, full-bodied red wine coming from vineyards of the legendary Masi family in Veneto, Italy. Arguably the regions most prestigious red. The grapes used to make modern Amarone wines are of the Corvina variety. They are picked in whole bunches and kept in drying rooms, where they stay for three to four months. Delicious.

Châteauneuf-Du-Pape, Château de Beaucastel, 2019 €45

Châteauneuf -Du-Pape, Rhône Valley

Who doesn't love a good Châteauneuf-du-Pape? It was officially the very first French wine appellation, created in 1936. Châteauneuf-du-Pape is considered – by most – to be the benchmark of the Southern Rhône and are usually always good. This beauty bursts with rich raspberry and plummy fruit flavours. As it evolves, you'll taste notes of dusted leather, game and herbs.

CORAVIN WHITE WINES

Matsu La Jefa Toro Blanco, 2018, Malvasia  €26

Toro, Spain

This is a rare wine by any standard and something to try if you love rich white wines. It comes from vines that are between 50 and 150 years old, in the Toro region of Spain and the result is an intense and full-bodied white wine with mouth-watering acidity and flavours of creamy vanilla, melon, apricots and peaches. Try it – it's absolutely stunning, with big flavours that will really compliment your meal.

Saint-Romain, Róisín Curley, 2021, Chardonnay   €30

Saint-Romain, Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France

Here's another masterpiece from the famous Irish winemaker negociant Róisín Curley. This Burgundy comes from the appellation of St-Romain which is renowned for its white wines made from the Chardonnay grape. This one has all the attributes of the classic white Burgundy with brioche, roasted almonds and citrus notes. We think you'll really like it as it's an exceptional wine and because it's produced in such small quantities, you won't find it on many other wine lists.

Domaine Patrice Moreux Pouilly-Fumé, 2023, Sauvignon Blanc €18

Pouilly Fumé, Loire Valley, France

This is a wine made by Patrice Moreux who believes in the harmony between working the vines and their natural environment using fully sustainable wine-making techniques with a simple philosophy: Wine is our church. Pouilly Fumé is a 100% Sauvignon Blanc with a clear yellow hue, an expressive nose, citrus, blackcurrant leaf and a touch of flint. Enjoy this lovely wine as you reflect on just how much thought and effort that gone into perfecting it.

CORAVIN WHITE WINES

Domaine Schlumberger, «Kitterle» Grand Cru, Riesling, 2017  €40

Alsace, France

Riesling is being regarded as one of the greatest white grape varieties in the world, and is known to be one of the biggest successes of French Alsace.

Originated in 15th century, the "Kitterle" has been known as an exceptional terroir, where sandstone meet volcanic rocks, shaped in terraces. As legend states, a tomcat with mischievous spirit used to live in the area of Upper Saering. The Schwab name for tomcat is Kuter, which may have changed throughout the years to the vineyard called Kitterle. The wine is ideal to accompany a cuisine based on the sea, especially great with Flaggy Shore oysters.

Grgich Hills Estate, 2020, Chardonnay €35

Napa Valley, California, USA

Mike Grgich gained international recognition after becoming an undisputed winner of the famous «Paris Judgements» of 1976. The blind tasting, where the finest Burgundy whites faced lesser known at that time and undiscovered wines from Napa, California in a blind tasting. The judges were shocked: they had chosen the 1973 Chateau Montelena Chardonnay, crafted by Mike Grgich as the finest white wine in the world! The results stunned the international wine establishment and earned Mike a reputation as one of the greatest winemakers in the world, bringing Grgich Hills Wine Estate to a world recognition.

IRISH WINE GEESE

Who are these Irish Wine Geese we speak of? let's start long ago, at the beginning.

At the end of the Williamite War in Ireland in 1691, the Treaty of Limerick meant that the Irish Jacobite army under the command of Patrick Sarsfield has to leave Ireland. They went to France and that migration became known as The Flight of the Wild Geese. Many of those soldiers and their descendants settled down around the port of Bordeaux and became very successful merchants and later owned properties, estates and vineyards there. We Irish have always been very fond of the wine from this region – in 1740 alone Ireland imported over 4,000 caskets, compared to the 1,000 that were sent to England. Irish winemakers of that time, and subsequent ones, were named the Irish Wine Geese and their influence on vineyards globally continues to grow every year. These are the exiled Irishmen who turned world-renowned winemakers together with other Irish men and women who followed in their footsteps in later years, not out of necessity, but out of love for fine wine. The Wine Geese have produced some truly outstanding wines and we have brought just some of them here for you to enjoy today.
