### **What We Discover**

How animals use sound to communicate and keep their families safe.

### **What We Do**

At the Stones Behind the Spa

### **What We Discover**

Why speed is important for animals that live in open landscapes.

### **What We Do**

Mini Rangers run or fast-walk a short distance, imagining how a blackbuck moves across wide grasslands to stay safe from danger.

Energy and movement  
Simple ideas of speed  
Confidence through active play

## **ARABIAN HORSE GAME**

Opposite Amwaj Sign

### **What We Discover**

The grace, strength and patience of the Arabian horse.

### **What We Do**

Mini Rangers take turns aiming and gently tossing, learning to focus, encourage one another and enjoy the moment together.

Hand-eye coordination  
Patience and turn-taking  
Respect for animals and heritage

## GAZELLE TRACK MEMORY

At the DIRS Bridges

### **What We Discover**

How rangers look for clues in nature to understand where animals have been.

### **What We Do**

Mini Rangers observe simple shapes and horn patterns, then recreate them in the sand from memory, just like a wildlife tracker.

### **What We Discover**

## **CROWNED CRANE DANCE**

Under the DIRS Bridge

### **What We Discover**

How animals use movement and dance to communicate and celebrate.

Mini Rangers watch a crowned crane dance and then move together, copying the bird's graceful steps.

## **GIRAFFE FOOTPRINT WALK**

At the Pond Opposite Villas

### **What We Discover**

How large animals move differently from smaller ones.

### **What We Do**

Mini Rangers play a Giraffe Freeze Game, moving tall and slow before freezing in a giraffe pose. They then practise balance by walking with long strides while keeping an object steady on their head.
