



Teen Trailblazers | Lead and Conserve

Minimum of 2 to a maximum of 6 participants per batch.
Supervised by the Recreation Team and/or Activity Guide.

Trailblazers is an advanced, expedition-style programme for teenagers aged 13 to 16, designed to build leadership, environmental responsibility, critical thinking, and teamwork.

Participants are challenged to think like future conservation leaders — analysing situations, making decisions, and presenting solutions — guided by professional facilitators.

Activity 1

WILDLIFE RESEARCH & CONSERVATION ANALYSIS

What We Discover

How wildlife is studied and protected through observation, data, and responsible decision-making.

What We Do

Trailblazers examine animal tracks, habitat clues, and conservation scenarios. Teams analyse movement patterns and prepare a short ranger-style briefing on how rangers respond responsibly.

What We Learn

Critical analysis and interpretation
Conservation decision-making
Clear and confident communication



Activity 2

WILDERNESS SAFETY & SURVIVAL PLANNING

What We Discover

How preparation and leadership keep people and wildlife safe in protected environments.

What We Do

Trailblazers take part in a guided safety and survival workshop, including map reading, emergency signalling, and risk-based scenario planning.

What We Learn

Judgement and accountability
Situational awareness
Calm, structured problem-solving

Activity 3

ARCHERY & FOCUS DISCIPLINE

What We Discover

How discipline and control support both performance and safety.

What We Do

Trailblazers learn correct stance, breathing, and equipment handling, practising precision under full instructor supervision.

What We Learn

Concentration and self-discipline
Safety awareness
Respect for structured rules

ISLAND EXPEDITION LEADERSHIP CHALLENGE

What We Discover

How strong leadership brings planning, people, and purpose together.

What We Do

Teams design and present a mock island expedition, covering safety, navigation, team roles, and environmental protection, followed by the Trailblazer Pledge.

Collaboration and accountability
Purpose and belonging
