Drink in unrivalled views overlooking the Zambezi River



THE ROYAL LIVINGSTONE EXPRESS TRAIN

Culinary journeys of a lifetime

Inspiring modern travellers with an authentic experience of vintage travel, The Royal Livingstone Express steam locomotive combines the exquisite fine dining and exceptional service of The Royal Livingstone Hotel by Anantara in Zambia with the elegance of Victorian times. Reliving the nostalgic journey of the sophisticated 20's era, guests can savour a moveable feast alongside a classic steam expedition.

Reliving a bygone era and impressing connoisseur tastes

Guests relax in the steam locomotive's lovingly restored Pullman-style coaches. Fulfilling romantic fantasies, The Royal Livingstone Express departs in the late afternoon and heads towards the Victoria Falls Bridge, while guests toast with sparkling wine or a cocktail accompanied by canapés.



The train stops between Zambia and Zimbabwe, on the Victoria Falls Bridge, one of the world's most spectacular border posts. In this unique spot directly above the Zambezi River, guests have the chance to disembark the train and enjoy the sunset besides the world's largest waterfall, the perfect location for breathtaking photo opportunities.

Voyaging through Zambia's resplendent landscapes, an impeccable five-course dinner by Anantara chefs is served with wines, beers and soft drinks. The journey on The Royal Livingstone Express is truly a classical experience of vintage travel, providing guests with an opportunity to take in a piece of history against the backdrop of the Victoria Falls. The Royal Livingstone Express accommodates up to 92 guests and can also be reserved for private hire for a minimum of 50 guests.



EXCURSIONS

No visit to The Royal Livingstone Hotel by Anantara is complete without standing in awe of the magnificent Victoria Falls, located just upstream from our hotel. For a broader view of wild Africa, our inspirational excursions invite you to set out on a safari drive, game viewing cruise or adrenalin pumping river adventures.

Victoria Falls

Zambia's main attraction is only a 10 minute walk from the hotel and as a Royal Livingstone guest you enjoy unlimited complimentary access to Victoria Falls via our own private entrance. Mosi-oa-Tunya, the Smoke that Thunders is the local name for this legendary waterfall.

Water taxi arrival on the Zambezi River

Start your Victoria Falls experience in Zambia with a luxurious and elegant water taxi transfer to The Royal Livingstone Victoria Falls Zambia Hotel by Anantara, one of only two hotels on the Zambian side of the Falls to offer this tranquil transfer.

Helicopter flight through Batoka Gorge

Enjoy a once in a lifetime helicopter ride and watch from above as the mighty Zambezi River carves its way through the steep cliffs of the Batoka Gorge and transforms from a gentle and serene river into the rampant Victoria Falls that descend 120 metres to the floor of the valley.

Dare to swim in Devil's Pool at Victoria Falls

Visit the historic Livingstone Island and have a swim at what feels like the edge of the world in the Devil's Pool. Visitors to the pool often can't see that the floor of the falls is 350m down on the other side of the pool, the falls are world-renowned as 'the smoke that thunders' for the rainbowed mist that rises after the water falls such a distance.

Microlight flight over the Victoria Falls

If you're seeking a different type of flying adventure, you can feel the falls spray on your face as you soar over its majesty in a microlight or view it from above in the slightly more sedate Batoka Gorge cable car.

White-water rafting on the Zambezi River

You can get up close and personal with the might of the Zambezi around the falls in a thrilling white-water rafting experience on the Zambia side of the falls, steering your way through the powerful rapids under the supervision of experienced river guides.

Swimming below the Victoria Falls

Once you're done marvelling at the falls from above, it's time to go for a swim in the rock pools below the Victoria Falls. With the massive basaltic rock surrounding you, and the shower of water gushing down, this is a truly remarkable experience.
