

EXPLORING LUXURY

The Anantara Angkor Resort in Siem Reap has upped the luxury ante with the unveiling of two presidential suites inspired by the explorers of old. Part of a magnificent new look for the 39-room boutique hideaway, the Henri Mouhot and Anantara Explorer Suites gives off old world charm and contemporary luxury in equal measure; the two-bedroom 235sqm Henri Mouhot Suite caters to six guests and pays tribute to the French naturalist and explorer who alerted the West to the ruins of Angkor, capital of the ancient Khmer civilisation of Cambodia, in 1860, while the one-bedroom 178sqm Anantara Explorer Suite was inspired by Jim Thompson, a former CIA officer who founded the Jim Thompson Thai Silk Company. Both suites feature imported Thai silks and fabrics, lounge and bar areas complete with a wine humidor; two dining areas; marble bathrooms with double vanity, bathtub and oversized rain shower; dressing rooms; a private spa room with a Jacuzzi bath tub; and a plunge pool in an enclosed private garden.
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
